**Expenses:** Please note that all expenses associated with the lecture tour are paid by the AEESP Foundation and host schools must agree to pay a flat fee of \$1,500 (U.S. and Canadian schools) or \$2,500 (outside of North America) to the Foundation in order to be placed on the lecture schedule. Failure to pay the lecture fee will preclude your institution from further participation as a host school until any outstanding invoices are paid. School host fees in future years are subject to adjustment.
